

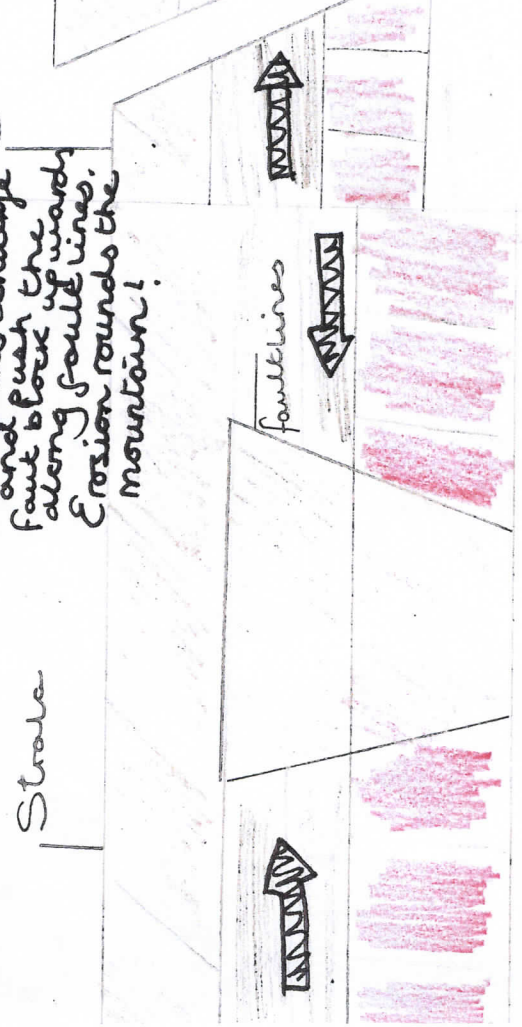
Fold Mountains:

Fold mountains are formed when plate tectonics converge creating a mountain (mount Everest).



Fault block Mountains:

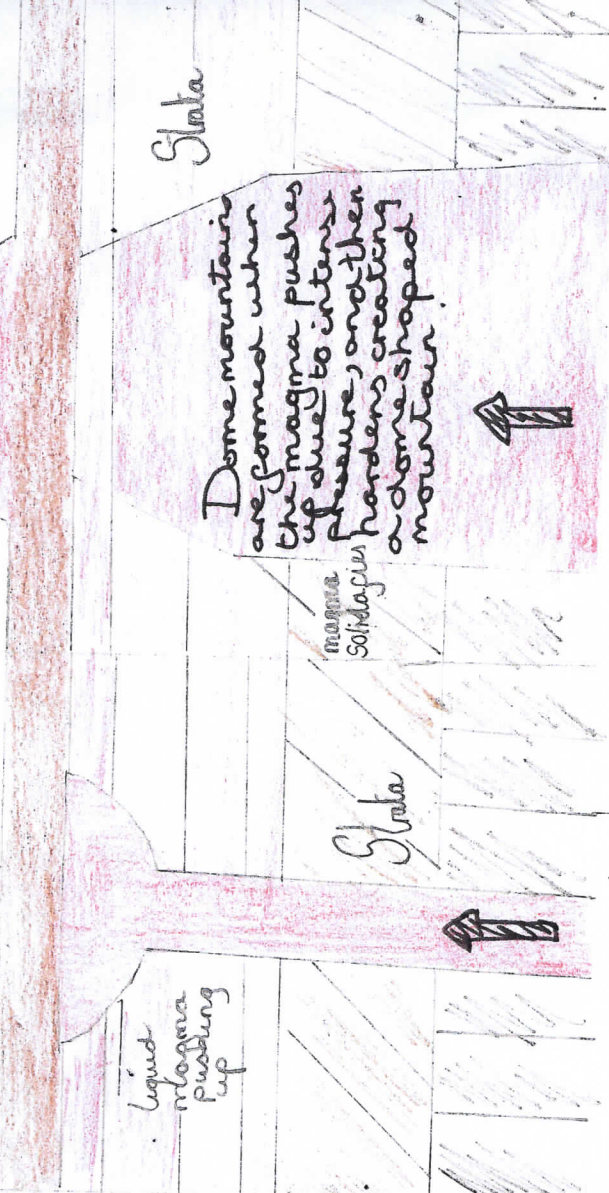
Fault block mountains are formed when the plates converge and push the fault block upwards. Erosion rounds the mountain!

Dome mountains are formed when the magma pushes up due to intense pressure, and then hardens creating a dome-shaped mountain.
