What	Resources
Introduce the session objectives	PPT – objectives page
Starter – myth busting ‘outstanding’ teaching (pairs with limited feedback) Emphasise that outstanding teaching is characterised by pupil progress and the use of assessment to inform learning NOT by ‘teacher performance’	PPT - Myth busting statements Ofsted schedule extract for outstanding teaching
Use the subject-specific draft guidance/the ‘good to outstanding’ table to identify how to get from one to the other. (Emphasise this is ONLY to be used in subject inspections.)	Good to outstanding table

- challenge and inspire pupils
- systematically and effectively check pupils’ understanding throughout lessons
